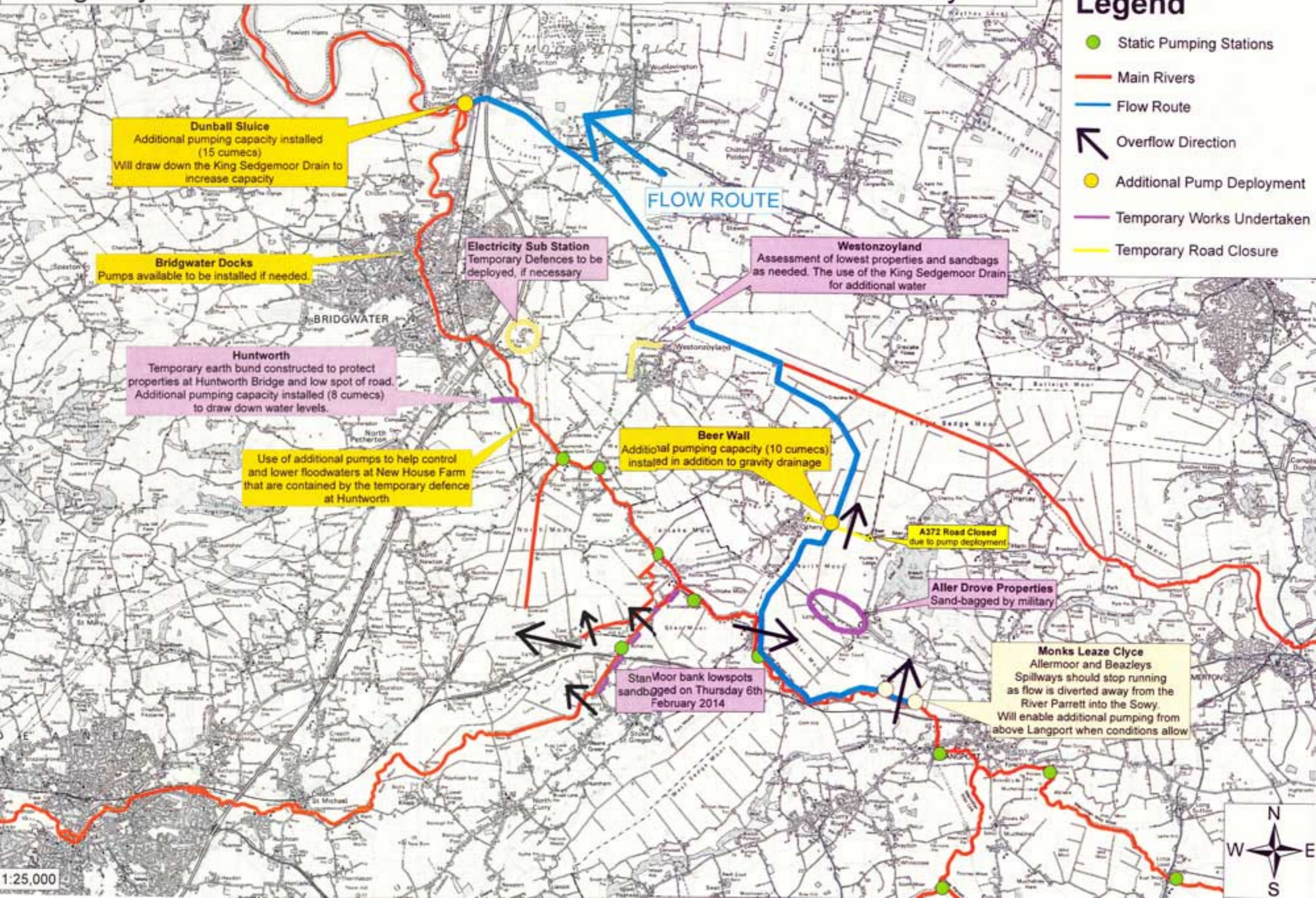


# Emergency Flood relief Works on Somerset Moors and Levels - February 2014

**Dunball Sluice**  
 Additional pumping capacity installed (15 cumecs)  
 Will draw down the King Sedgemoor Drain to increase capacity

**Bridgwater Docks**  
 Pumps available to be installed if needed.

**Huntworth**  
 Temporary earth bund constructed to protect properties at Huntworth Bridge and low spot of road. Additional pumping capacity installed (8 cumecs) to draw down water levels.

Use of additional pumps to help control and lower floodwaters at New House Farm that are contained by the temporary defence at Huntworth

**Electricity Sub Station**  
 Temporary Defences to be deployed, if necessary

**Westonzoyland**  
 Assessment of lowest properties and sandbags as needed. The use of the King Sedgemoor Drain for additional water

**Beer Wall**  
 Additional pumping capacity (10 cumecs) installed in addition to gravity drainage

**A372 Road Closed**  
 due to pump deployment

**Aller Drove Properties**  
 Sand-bagged by military

**Stan Moor bank lowspots**  
 sandbagged on Thursday 6th February 2014

**Monks Leaze Clyce**  
 Aller Moor and Beazleys  
 Spillways should stop running as flow is diverted away from the River Parrett into the Sowy. Will enable additional pumping from above Langport when conditions allow
