Various visits have been enjoyed to the Civil war memorial, Heritage Centre, Blake Museum, Knowle Hall and Tower, Ford Farm and the Rural life museum.

Looking to the future the group suggested several topics that it would like to explore. Visits to Brick and Tile Museum, Wembdon Road Cemetery and Sydenham Manor were also mentioned.

A number of artifacts have also been collected were on display at the meeting which brought considerable interest and discussion. These included old sale Posters, A brochure for Silver Fish Hotel, Church report for 1902, School Awards board and Personal Memories of the local Home Guard.
